Important Facts

- February 6 & 7 are student holidays due to the LISD February Conference.
- There is a possibility of you missing up to 3 days of school.
- You will be required to attend your entire assignment for the days/week.
- Applications must be submitted online by the campus deadline
- On the application's Career Placement Preference section, consider your Program of Study and skills when selecting your top two choices. Be reasonable!
- COOL Week hours are typically 9:00 AM – 3:00 PM .
- You will be required to attend the entire day, even if you regularly have $\frac{3}{4}$ days, ACC classes, practice, etc. Check with your coaches/directors/extra-curricular sponsors before applying
- The school district does not provide any transportation.
- Some placements, including health science careers, may only be one or two days due lack of "hands on" opportunities and patient privacy restrictions.
- Applications will be processed in order of submission; a maximum of 75 students will be allowed to participate from each high school.

Basic COOL Week Student Timeline

TARGET DATES (Subject to change)

September COOL Week introduction & application process

October 19 - Initial Student Orientation with students who have applied to begin the job matching process (**attendance required**)

November-December - Individual student interviews for placement

January 23 – 30 - (Each campus has one date within that timeframe) Students attend training session to receive COOL Week assignment details, meet team members, exchange contact information, work out transportation issues, etc. (**required**)

February 6 – 7 - Students attend COOL Week as assigned – **NOT counted as an absence**

February 13 – 20 - Campus date to be determined: COOL Week Celebration - Thank You letters due (**required**)
