LISD Graduates Score above State and National Averages on ACT

Leander ISD Superintendent Bret Champion announced that even amid a 21-percent increase in the number of ACT exams given, the district's composite scores on the ACT college-entrance exam continue to be higher than state and national averages. For 2015, the average ACT composite score (scale of 1 – 36) for an LISD graduate was 23.9, while the state and national average composite scores were 20.9 and 21.0 respectively.
