Official Rules

- 1) Applications are due no later than 5:00 pm Friday, Feb 17, 2012.
- 2) Auditions will be held at the Leander High School Little Theatre (3301 S. Bagdad, Leander, TX 78641) at 6:30 pm on Feb 21 and Feb 23, 2012. There will be limited audition time each evening and will be granted on a first come first serve basis. **Accompanist will not be provided.**
- 3) There is a \$7 application/audition fee. Fee must be collected prior to auditioning. You can mail in the fee with your application or pay at audition night. Please make checks payable to Cedar Park Rotary Club. Those applicants with a financial hardship may request the fee be waived. Requests must be reviewed and approved by audition committee.
- 4) The top 10 acts in each Division will be selected from auditions to perform in the final show night – Friday Night, March 2 at 7:00 pm at the Don Tew Performing Arts Center at Leander High School.
- 5) Scoring will be done by a panel of three judges.
- 6) Performances will be scored on the following 4 categories: Talent, Originality, Audience Response, and Stage Presence.
- 7) Only those performances making it to the final show night are eligible for cash prizes.
- 8) Cash prizes will consist of \$1000 for our Overall Show Winner. Each Division winner will receive \$500 and runner ups in each Division will receive \$250. The Overall Winner is not eligible for Division cash prizes.
- 9) A maximum of 5 individuals are eligible to perform in each act unless an exception is granted by the audition committee.
- 10) Performers will be permitted to perform in one act only.
- 11) A mandatory rehearsal will be held on Thurs night, Mar 1 at 7:00 pm.
- 12) Basic sound equipment will be available for performers. However, no special lighting or special effects (smoke machines, special scenery, etc..) may be used. Please list all technical needs on the application provided. You will need to arrange for your own accompanist if applicable.
- 13) Each act is limited to 5 mins of actual performance time and 2 mins of set up and breakdown time. If a performer exceeds the 5 minute performance time, a deduction of 1 point will be assessed in the overall rating score.
- 14) All performances should be in good taste and rated for all ages. Acts containing music, lyrics, gestures, costumes or material that judges consider to be rude or offensive will not be permitted.
- 15) Most importantly, have fun!! It should be a great night for all!
