The Middle School league will begin with evaluations. It will be run by a staff member at the YMCA. The coaches will be present to evaluate the players. There will be two days of drills and at the end of the second day preliminary teams will be made and a scrimmage will be held. Final decisions on teams will be made on Sept. 4th. Practices will be held beginning the following week at the YMCA. Games will be held on Fridays and Saturdays. Weekly scores and individual team records will be posted on our website. A single elimination tournament will be played at the end of the season. Games for the tournament will be decided based on rankings.
