Important Facts

- Monday, February 18 is a student holiday. Businesses may want you to come that day.
- Many businesses only participate 2 or 3 days, but some still want to have a full week.
- You will be required to attend your entire assignment for the days/week. Be mindful of whether or not you can accept a full week assignment.
- Applications must be submitted online by the campus deadline
- On the application's Career Placement Preference section, consider your Program of Study and skills when selecting your top two choices. Be reasonable!
- COOL Week hours are typically 9:00 AM – 3:00 PM .
- You will be required to attend the entire day, even if you regularly have $\frac{3}{4}$ days, ACC classes, practice, etc. Check with your coaches/directors/extra-curricular sponsors before applying
- The school district does not provide any transportation.
- Some placements, including health science careers, may only be one or two days due lack of "hands on" opportunities and patient privacy restrictions.
- Applications will be processed in order of submission; a maximum of 75 students will be allowed to participate from each high school.

Basic COOL Week Student Timeline

TARGET DATES (Subject to change)

September - COOL Week introduction & application process

October – Senior Summit - Initial Student Orientation with students who have applied to begin the job matching process (**attendance required**)

November - January - Individual student interviews for placement

Early February - Students attend training session to receive COOL Week assignment details, meet team members, exchange contact information, work out transportation issues, etc. (**required**)

February 18 - 22 - Students attend COOL Week as assigned – **NOT counted as an absence**

February 25 - 28 - Campus date to be determined: COOL Week Celebration - Thank You letters due (**required**)
